Compton Verney, a registered charity, is an extraordinary place with a mission to make art, nature and creativity available to all. As an award-winning nationally accredited gallery, based in a Grade I-listed Georgian mansion amidst 120 acres of Grade II-listed Lancelot 'Capability' Brown parkland in Warwickshire, we have six permanent art collections alongside a schedule of thought-provoking evolving exhibitions and events both outdoors and in.

About the summer weekender events

This year we will be hosting an incredible series of summer weekenders over July and August, for people of all ages to get involved with and enjoy. Taking place outdoors across the site, there will be 5 weekender events in total happening, with different themes, varying companies and artists. Our lineup includes:

- **Weekender 1** – Ringworld and storytelling – colourful inflatable structures to imagine and play in, with a story tree to immerse children in tales and stories linking to the artwork.
- **Weekender 2** – Woodland tribe – the UK's master of constructive play, children embarking on a journey of imagination and creation.
- **Weekender 3** – Seagulls and Circus – with a mixture of showmanship and family fun a traditional circus to entertain and inspire audiences.
- **Weekender 4** – Taiko drumming and dance puppets – inviting everyone to join in with high energy Japanese drumming workshops and engaging with a moving talk about the earth's climate emergency.
- **Weekender 5** – Family rave – bringing its bass to Compton Verney this is a family friendly rave for everyone to dance to.

This role will span across all the above events, putting people at the heart through their engagement and enjoyment.
