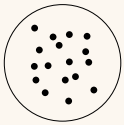
The Adam Hall

Named after the Neoclassical architect Robert Adam, whose designs drew inspiration from the classical art of Ancient Greece and Rome, The Adam Hall is a focal point within our Grade I-listed mansion.

With large picture windows, intricate decorations across the ceiling and walls and views across the grounds, The Adam Hall is the perfect location to inspire delegates.

The Adam Hall can be hired as a stand-alone space, or can be used as a central conference room alongside other break-out spaces.

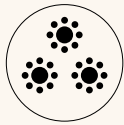

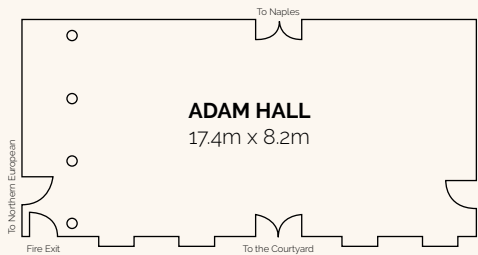

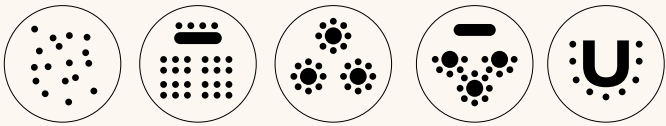


The Old Servants Hall

The Old Servants Hall is a modern and versatile room with an original fireplace and high ceiling. Conveniently situated next to the gallery's main entrance, this room is fitted with a wall-mounted TV for presentations and virtual meetings.

The Old Servants Hall is a private meeting space, perfect for meetings and team away days. The room can be hired on a stand-alone basis or can act as a catering space, breakout space, or evening bar area when hiring the Adam Hall.

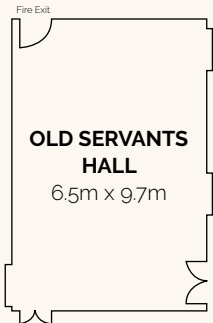

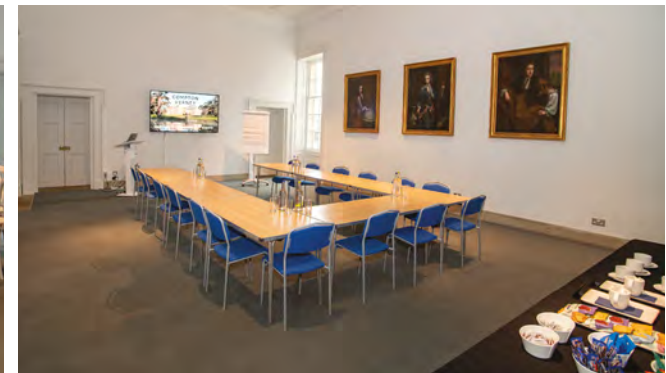

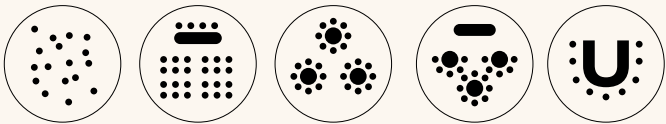
The Wellingtonia Gallery

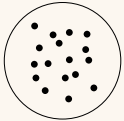


The Women's Library

The Women's Library stands today as a space for reflection and discovery, and is the perfect location for intimate meetings, such as board or strategy meetings.

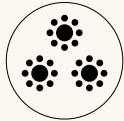

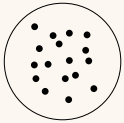
The Galleries

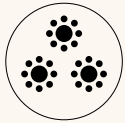

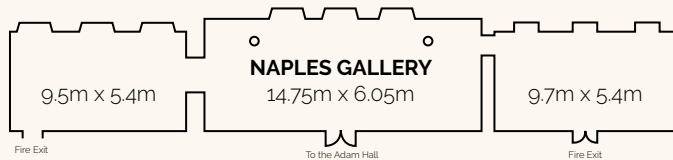

When Richard Verney acquired the land that is now the Compton Verney estate in the fifteenth century, the land already had a rich heritage dating back to the Middle Ages.

The grounds as we now know them were designed by the eminent landscape architect Lancelot 'Capability' Brown in the 18th century, and are also now home to Sculpture in the Park, our trail of large-scale artworks from eminent contemporary artists.

FAQs

What is included in the venue hire fee?

The venue hire fee includes exclusive use of the agreed event space(s), parking for event attendees and access to Compton Verney's galleries, exhibitions and grounds. The fee also includes AV and furniture set up as standard. Depending on the scale of the hire, the fee also includes a dedicated Event Manager or Team to support on the day, security and cleaning.

Can we use our own suppliers?

As a Grade I-listed building with priceless artworks on display, we require our clients to use our dedicated in-house catering team, or we ask them to choose from our list of exclusive catering partners. We can also make recommendations for venue stylists, florists and entertainment. Any external suppliers must supply up-to-date and adequate Public Liability Insurance, PAT Testing Certificates, and Risk Assessments.

Are there conservation regulations for spaces?

Our Galleries are full of original artworks, and so there are conservation rules in place, depending on the style of event. Seated dinners in the galleries can be serviced with a full range of drinks, while drinks reception in the galleries must be pale drinks and canapes only. Real flowers are not permitted in the galleries; dried or artificial alternatives are welcome. No candles can be lit in the mansion house. The fabrication of the venue and its fixtures cannot be damaged, moved or relocated in any way.

What are your standard hire times?

The standard hire period for day-time meetings is from 9am to 5pm. The evening hire period is 6pm to 11:30pm. Alternative event timings and access times for suppliers can be advised on a case-by-case basis. The site is open to the public Tuesday - Sunday 10am-5pm.

What support can we expect on the day?

Our Venue Hire Team can assist with planning the elements of your event. Depending on the scale of your event, you will be supported on the day of your event by a dedicated Event Manager, and our on-site Facilities Team are also available during opening hours

What is access like across your site and hireable spaces?

We have 12 Blue Badge parking bays in the car park, and the footpaths throughout the park are wheelchair friendly with a few slight inclines. There is also an accessible shuttle bus which runs during opening hours. The entrance to the Gallery is ramped and there are level floors throughout the ground floor to each hireable space. Accessible toilets can also be located in the Welcome Centre and the ground floor.

By Car

From the M40 take Junction 12 or Junction 15 and follow the brown signs.

By Train

The nearest train stations are Leamington Spa, Stratford-Upon-Avon, Warwick Parkway and Banbury.

Accessibility

Our galleries are 580m from our car park, there is a fully accessible shuttle bus that can take you. Large print guides, portable seating and hearing loops are available, and assistance dogs are welcome. Please let us know in advance if anyone in your group has mobility or access requirements. All hireable spaces are on the ground floor.

Parking & Coach Arrivals

If your party is arriving in individual cars, there is a car park with ample disabled parking for Blue Badge holders, and two electric charging points. We have a coach drop off space available, as well as parking on site* subject to availability
